Graduate School of Theology

Master of Arts Degrees (45 credits)

Master of Arts in Biblical Studies

Designed for the student who desires to preach, write, or teach Bible and theology in a variety of educational and ministerial settings. It provides training in the exegesis and interpretation of Scripture. Specific concentrations offered:

Master of Arts in Ministerial Studies

Designed for the student who desires to serve in one of the ministries of the church, especially that of pastor, evangelist, or teacher. Master of Divinity Degrees (78 credits)

Doctor of Ministry Degree (DMin)

Prerequisites: Master of Divinity or equivalent, verifiable ministerial accreditation/credentials, and a minimum of three years of active ministry experience.

The 30-credit doctoral requirement includes doctoral core courses, courses in the area of specialization, and a doctoral dissertation project with research and proposal as well as writing and defense.
