Doctor of Ministry Degrees

Prerequisites: Master of Divinity or equivalent, verifiable ministerial accreditation/credentials, and a minimum of three years of active ministry experience.

The 30-credit doctoral requirement includes doctoral core courses, courses in the area of specialization, and a doctoral dissertation project with research and proposal as well as writing and defense.
